



## Chulu East Peak Climbing (6564m)

### Itinerary(A) Detail of Chulu East Peak Climbing

**Mar12/Day 01:** Arrival in Kathmandu airport and Hotel transfer;

**Mar13/Day 02:** We meet all other expedition members and the leader, conduct initial briefing and preparations and we will have an opportunity to do last minute shopping in Kathmandu

**Mar14/Day 03:** We take 7hrs scenic drive from Kathmandu to Besi Sahar (823m). We will stop several times during the trip to try some local cuisine; teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar15/Day 04:** We trek 6hrs from Besi Sahar to Bahundanda (1305m); Before Bahundanda we catch glimpses of Manaslu; teahouse accommodation or camping

**Mar16/Day 05:** We trek 6hrs from Bahundanda to Chyamche (1430m) along subtropical sections of Marsyangdi River Valley; teahouse accommodation or camping

**Mar17/Day 06:** We trek 6hrs from Chyamche (1410m.) to Dharapani (1860m); teahouse accommodation or camping

**Mar18/Day 07:** We trek 6hrs from Dharapani to Chame (2670m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar19/Day 08:** We trek 5hrs from Chame to Upper Pisang (3100m);, teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar20/Day 09:** We trek 5hrs from Upper Pisang to Ngawal (3305m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar21/Day 10:** Acclimatization rest in Ngawal; teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar22/Day 11:** We trek 6hrs Ngawal to Chulu Base Camp (4500m.) ; camping

**Mar23/Day 12:** We trek 6hrs from Chulu Base Camp to High Camp (5400m); camping

**Mar24/Day 13:** We do acclimatize here if we feel uncomfortable. If we feel well, we are going to attempt the summit(6564m); camping

**Mar25/Day 14:** This is our scheduled summit day; from the summit we will return to the Base Camp; camping

**Mar26/Day 15:** We trek from Chulu Base Camp to Manang (3540m.); Manang has airport and it is possible to fly out to Pokhara for people with limited time; teahouse accommodation or camping.





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**Mar27/Day 16:** Trek 6hrs from Manang, to Thorong Phedi (4450m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar28/Day 17:** Trek 7hrs from Trong Phedi to Muktinath (3800m) via Thorong-La pass (5,416m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar29/Day 18:** Trek 5hrs from Muktinath to Jomsom via Kagbeni(2895m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar30/Day 19:** WE take 20mins flight from Jomsom to Pokhara; hotel accommodation.

**Mar31/Day 20:** We take 7hrs scenic drive from Pokhara to Kathmandu. We will stop several times during the trip to try some local cuisine; alternatively there is 25mins flight available from Pokhara to Kathmandu; hotel accommodation.



**Apr01/Day 21:** Full Day sightseeing in Kathmandu valley (DurbarSquare, Swoyambhunath, Boudhanath & Pashupatinath); Nepalese cultural program with farewell dinner in the evening.

**Apr02/Day 22:** Transfer to the airport for final departure, or alternative join other activities

## Alternative Option from Day 17 to complete Full Annapurna Circui:



**Mar29/Day 18:** Trek 6hrs from Muktinath to Marpha (2667m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar30/Day 19:** Trek 6hrs from Marpha to Ghasa (2013m). Your trail descends steeply through forests to Ghasa, the last Thakali village and the southern-most limit of Tibetan Buddhism; teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Mar31/Day 20:** Trek 5hrs from Ghasa to Tatopani (1189 m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Apr01/Day 21:** A rest day in Tatopani to enjoy the natural hot springs. After several days of trekking, it is a welcome relaxing for most of our clients

**Apr02/Day 22:** Trek 6hrs from Tatopani to Beni (1050m) and then drive to Pokhara (70km)

**Apr03/Day 23:** We take 7hrs scenic drive from Pokhara to Kathmandu. We will stop several times during the trip to try some local cuisine; alternatively there is 25mins flight available from Pokhara to Kathmandu; hotel accommodation.

**Apr04/Day 24:** Full Day sightseeing in Kathmandu valley (DurbarSquare, Swoyambhunath, Boudhanath & Pashupatinath); Nepalese cultural program with farewell dinner in the evening.

**Apr05/Day 25:** Transfer to the airport for final departure, or alternative join other activities

**Apr08/Day 18:**Trek 5hrs from Muktinath to Jomsom via Kagbeni(2895m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

**Apr09/Day 19:**WE take 20mins flight from Jomsom to Pokhara; hotel accommodation.

**Apr10/Day 20:**We take 7hrs scenic drive from Pokhara to Kathmandu. We will stop several times during the trip to try some local cuisine; alternatively there is 25mins flight available from Pokhara to Kathmandu; hotel accommodation.

- First Aid medical kits for the Group and the staffs.
- Satellite phone carrying by Guide for communication and available for members with the cost of US\$ 4 per minute call.
- Appropriate food for high altitude and all climbing crew at base camp and above as required.
- Required fixed and dynamic rope during climbing period.
- Emergency Oxygen and mask regulator.
- All necessary paper works, office Service charge and Government Taxes levied in Nepal
- Complete pre-departure information, flight ticket reconfirmation and visa extension procedure services (if necessary)
- Farewell Dinner in a typical Nepali restaurant with domestic culture show in Kathmandu before departure.
