Itinerary Details of Lobuche Peak Climbing

Mar14/Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu airport and Hotel transfer

Mar15/Day 02: Preparation, Briefings, Last minute shopping in Kathmandu

Mar16/Day 03: Flight from Kathmandu to Lukla; Trek (4hrs) to Phakding (2652m); lodge accommodation or camping

Mar17/Day 04: We trek 6hrs from Phakding to Namche Bazaar (3440m) through colourful Khumbu villages; Lodge accommodation or camping

Mar18/Day 05: We take a day for acclimatization; you can hike to famous Everest View Hotel (3800m) (3hrs) to catch the view of Everest; back at Namche visit Hilary and Sherpa museum

Mar19/Day 06: We trek 5hrs from Namche Bazaar to Tengboche (3850m); visit significant Buddhist monastery; lodge accommodation or camping

Mar20/Day 07: We trek 5hrs from Tengboche to Pheriche (4240m); catch glimpses of Lhotse and Ama Dablam; lodge accommodation or camping

Mar21/Day 08: We trek 5hrs from Pheriche to Lobuche (4910m); we catch first glimpses of Lobuche; lodge accommodation or camping

Mar22/Day 09: We trek 5hrs from Lobuche to Kala Patthar via Gorakshep (5125m); lodge accommodation or camping at Gorak Shep

Mar23/Day 10: Trek from Gorak Shep to Everest Base Camp (5254m) and back to Gorak Shep.

Mar24/Day 11: We trek 5hrs from Gorak Shep to Everest Base Camp (5254m) and back to Gorakshep; lodge accommodation or camping

Mar25/Day 12: Acclimatization rest day at Lobuche Base Camp; preparation for the summit

Mar26/Day 13: We climb Lobuche East (6119m) summit and return to Base Camp (10hrs)

Mar27/Day 14: We trek 5hrs from Lobuche Base Camp to Dingboche (4410m); lodge accommodation or camping

Mar28/Day 15: We trek 5hrs from Dingboche to Namche Bazaar (3440m); lodge accommodation or camping

Mar29/Day 16: We trek 7hrs from Namche Bazaar to Lukla (2840m) through scenic Khumbu; This last evening in the mountains is the ideal opportunity for a farewell party with our staff.

Mar30/Day 17: We take again scenic flight from Lukla to Kathmandu, which takes about 35 minutes.

Mar31/Day 18: Leisure day; sightseeing in Kathmandu (Durbar Square, Swoyambhunath, Boudhanath, Pashupatinath); Fairwell-Celebration dinner



Mar32/Day 19: Transfer to the airport for final departure or alternatively join other activities

- Required Experienced, Trained and Government Licensed Climbing Guide(s) during Climbing Period as per the size of group.
- All wages, equipments, medical and accidental Insurances for all involved staffs.
- First Aid medical kits for the Group and the staffs.
- Satellite phone carrying by Guide for communication and available for members with the cost of US\$ 4 per minute call.
- Appropriate food for high altitude and all climbing crew at base camp and above as required.
- Required fixed and dynamic rope during climbing period.
- Emergency Oxygen and mask regulator.
- All necessary paper works, office Service charge and Government Taxes levied in Nepal
- Complete pre-departure information, flight ticket reconfirmation and visa extension procedure services (if necessary)
- Farewell Dinner in a typical Nepali restaurant with domestic culture show in Kathmandu before departure.
