



Naya Kanga Peak Climbing

Itinerary Details of Naya Kanga Pea Climbing

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu airport and Hotel transfer.

Day 02: We meet all other expedition members and the leader, conduct initial briefing and preparations, issue climbing permit and we will have an opportunity to do last minute shopping in Kathmandu.

Day 03: We take 8hrs a scenic drive from Kathmandu along Trishuli River Valley to Sybrubensi (1503m) North of Kathmandu via Dhunche village; teahouse accommodation or camping.

Day 04: We trek 5hrs from Sybrubensi to Lama Hotel (2410m); we will walk along the Bhote Koshi and Langtang Khola via Bamboo, wich is famous for red Panda; teahouse accommodation.

Day 05: We trek 6hrs from Lama Hotel to Langtang (3430m) via Ghodatabela. At Ghodatabela (3000m), the trail emerges from the forest; teahouse accommodation or camping.

Day 06: We trek 5.5hrs from Lantang to Kyanjin Gumba (3830m); we should arrive at Kyanjin at lunchtime, giving us time to acclimatize and explore the area; teahouse accommodation or camping.

Day 07: We take acclimatizing rest at Kyanjin Gumba and visit the monastery and the cheese factory, walk up glaciers of Langtang Lirung or ascend Kyangjin Ri (4350m.) behind the village for a breathtaking panorama of the Langtang peaks; teahouse accommodation.

Day 08: We trek 6hrs from Kyanjin Gumba to Naya Kanga Base Camp (4300m); camping.

Day 09: We trek 6hrs from Naya Kanga Base Camp to Naya Kanga High Camp C1 (4950m); camping.

Day 10: We wake up early in the morning (at 3am), take some tea, coffee and light breakfast then summit Naya kanga Peak (5844m); we will down climb to the Base Camp.

Day 11: We trek 4hrs from the Base camp to Kyanjin Gumba (3830m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

Day 12: We trek 4hrs from Kyanjin Gumba to Lama Hotel (2410m); teahouse accommodation or camping.

Day 13: We trek 6hrs from Lama Hotel to Syaphrubesi (1600m) via Sherpagaon, The main inhabitants of this area belong to the Tamang community.

Day 14: From Syabru Besi we drive for 8hrs to Kathmandu (1350m) by bus or car and transfer to hotel.

Day 15: Full Day sightseeing in Kathmandu valley (Durbar Square, Swoyambhunath, Boudhanath & Pashupatinath); Farewell-Celebration dinner in the evening.



Day 16: Transfer to the airport for final departure or alternatively join other activities.

Notes:

- The above itinerary is a guideline and standard pattern, which we provide you. This Climbing/Expedition itinerary can be modified according to your time and requirements.
- The Itinerary may be changed after understanding by both agency and client. Additional activities could be added or reduce as per client's request before confirming the trip. Price for reduced activities (service) could be deducted and additional activities (service) could be added as per mutual understanding.



Cost Include

- Per person 20kg baggage allowance during trekking or climbing carrying by porter/Yaks.
- Trekking Permit (National Park entry fee) and TIMS card (Trekking Information Management System).
- Climbing permit for Naya Kanga (5,844m).
- Required Experienced, Trained and Government Licensed Climbing Guide(s) during Climbing Period as per the size of group.
- All wages, equipments, medical and accidental Insurances for all involved staffs.
- First Aid medical kits for the Group and the staffs.
- Appropriate food for high altitude and all climbing crew at base camp and above as required.
- Required fixed and dynamic rope during climbing period.
- Emergency Oxygen and mask regulator.
- All necessary paper works, office Service charge and Government Taxes levied in Nepal.
- Complete pre-departure information, flight ticket reconfirmation and visa extension procedure services (if necessary).
- Farewell Dinner in a typical Nepali restaurant with domestic culture show in Kathmandu before departure.
- Snowy Horizon Special Gifts (T-shirt/Pashmina etc.).
- Our service Charges.
